CORLEY - Carol "Hansie" Maxine Schneider, daughter of Lloyd and Ella (Neve) Schuning; was born Dec. 14, 1940, in Avoca. She was baptized and confirmed at Trinity Lutheran Church in Avoca. She attended Avoca schools, but as was common for the time she left school before graduating. However, she returned to Iowa Western and received her high school diploma in 1983. Carol met Frank Schneider on the steps of the old Corley Store.

They were united in marriage Dec. 15, 1958. Four children, all October births, were born to this union. They made their home in and around Corley their entire married life except for a short stay in California, while Frank was in the Army. After her children were grown, she worked for Wilwerding Milk Hauling, a short gig at CDS and finished her employment at Mickel's. She died of cancer at Myrtue Memorial Hospital March 17, 2001, at age 60 years, three months and three days.
