

Harry "Moe" Schuemann, 72

Sept. 25, 1930 - Aug. 20, 2003

JEFFERSON CITY – Harry G. Schuemann was born Sept. 25, 1930, in Harlan, son of Harry and Irma Hawkins Schuemann. He was a 1948 graduate of Avoca High School and attended Drake University in Des Moines for two years.

He was married June 10, 1950, in Harlan to Carol Ann Knouse. He worked for United/Sprint for 37 years, retiring as a forecast administrator. He then worked for Roche Bi-Medical for six years until his retirement. He was a former member of the Kiwanis Club. He died Aug. 20, 2003, at his home at age 72.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Carol, July 12, 2000.
