Feb. 10, 1910 - Oct. 20, 1999

IRWIN - Lillian Marie Schuler was born Feb. 10, 1910, at Jackson, MN, to Bernice (Davis) and Ernest Withers. She was baptized at the Church of Christ in Clarksville. She grew up on the family farm near Clarksville, and graduated in 1926, from Shell Rock High School, Shell Rock.

She married Sidney L. Schuler March 22, 1936, in Bristow. To this union one son was born. The couple ministered at Clarksville, Fertile, Correctionville, Irwin, Mondamin and Malta, MT, later returning to Irwin, where Sidney later died. She taught Sunday School and Bible School for many years. While living in Clarksville, she taught school for eight years. Following their return to Irwin, she worked as a cook for the Irwin Senior Center and the Nebowa Bible Camp near Onawa. She died Oct. 20, 1999, at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 89 years, eight months and 10 days.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Sidney Schuler, Feb. 26, 1975; sister, Dorothy; brother, Howard; and brother, Bill Haberman. Survivors include her son, Joseph Schuler, and friend, Karen Miller of Myrtle Beach, SC; granddaughter, Kimberly (Ken) Biladeau of Bozeman, MT; great grandson, Kalab Biladeau of Bozeman, MT; sister, Amy (Harold) Edeker of Roland; and other relatives.
