

## Clarence Schultz, 73 ✓

*April 7, 1926 – Dec. 15, 1999*

**MINDEN** – Clarence Alvin Schultz was born April 7, 1926, at Shelby, son of Albert and Hulda Peters Schultz and was one of 11 children in the family.

He married Helen Clark June 14, 1949, in Hiawatha, KS. They were the parents of three sons, William, Alan and Wayne. They made their home in the Minden area. He worked as a farmhand in the Minden area, worked for Merkert Feed and Grain in Minden, Western Iowa Pork Plant at Harlan, and the American Beef Plant in Omaha, NE and Oakland. He retired in 1983 because of ill health. He died at Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs, Dec. 15, 1999, after suffering an apparent heart attack at age 73 years, eight months and eight days.
