

## Edna K. Scott, 89

May 10, 1908 - July 10, 1997

**DEFIANCE** - Edna Kathryn Scott, daughter of Herman and Belle (Schaben) Pauley, was born May 10, 1908, at Westphalia. She was baptized and confirmed at St. Boniface Catholic Church in Westphalia and attended Westphalia Township School near Westphalia.

June of 1945, she married Robert Scott at Kansas City, MO. After they were married they lived in St. Louis, MO, moving back to Crawford County, IA in 1946, where they farmed. In 1969, they retired from farming, but continued to live in the country for several years before moving into their current home in Defiance. She was a member of St. Peter's Catholic Church and Women's Council in Defiance. In 1988, she became a resident of the Manilla Manor, where she resided until going to Mercy Hospital in Des Moines, for one month. It was there she died July 10, 1997, at age 89 years and two months.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her brothers and sisters, Susan Koppold, Isadore Pauley, Viola West and Bernard Pauley.
