ELK HORN — Steven George Sebeniecher, son of Robert and Rosenia (Mascher) Sebeniecher, was born Sept. 6, 1951, at Cheyenne, WY. He was baptized at Clarinda. He attended school at Clarinda and later attended Iowa School for the Deaf in Council Bluffs, graduating in 1970. Upon graduation, Steven attended Iowa Western Community College also in Council Bluffs. Following his college education, he was employed with the School of Mount Carmel near Carroll and later the Crouse Cartage Company of Carroll. He then worked for the City of Red Oak and the Danish Inn of Elk Horn for sixteen years.

Feb. 5, 1992, Steven married Pam Riggle in Atlantic. After their marriage, they made their home in Elk Horn. He died Dec. 30, at his home in Elk Horn at age 54 years, three months and 24 days.
