SILVER SPRING, MD – Morris Seltzer of Rossmoor Leisure World in Silver Spring, MD was born in New York City, NY and worked as an administrative assistant in the Federal Housing Administration before graduating from George Washington University Law School in 1945. He worked for the Navy Department from the mid-40's until retiring in 1973 as principal organization and management officer in the office of the chief of naval operations. He received the Navy Department's Superior Civilian Service Award. After retiring, he spent two years as a consultant and special assistant to the Navy Department's vice chief of naval operations. He was a member of the Rossmoor Leisure World Kiwanis Club. He died Nov. 16, 1999, at the Bedford Court Health Center in Silver Spring.
