HARLAN - Maude "Peg" Evelyn Sorenson, daughter of Leslie Edward and Edith Evelyn (Crosier) Green, was born Sept. 20, 1909, at her grandparents' home in St. Edward, NE. She was raised in Cedar Rapids, NE and graduated from high school there. Peg attended two years of college at the University of Nebraska in Lincoln, NE.

Nov. 26, 1930, she married Harold Kermit Sorenson in Cedar Rapids, NE, and the couple farmed near Harlan, for many years following their marriage. They spent many winters in Brownsville, TX, where Harold died May 4, 1989. She continued living in her own home until October, 1994, when she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home. She was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan. She died March 8, 1998, at the Baptist Memorial Home at age 88 years, five months and 16 days.

Preceding her in death were her parents; her husband, Harold; one brother, Claude Green, and one sister, Blanche Cornwell. Survivors include two nieces, Ila (Bob) Miller of Seattle, WA and Donna Conley of Spalding, NE; one nephew, Donald Green of Columbus, NE, and other relatives.
