## **Raymond Stormer, 67**

*April 10, 1934 – July 30, 2001*

**ATLANTIC** – Raymond Lester Stormer, son of Chester Oscar and Mary Evelyn Lane Stormer, was born April 10, 1934, in Atlantic, where he grew up and attended school. At age 13 he lived with his sister and brother-in-law, Maye and Ora Babbitt, northwest of Avoca in Shelby County. He served in the United States Navy and was honorably discharged Nov. 16, 1956.

He married Sandy Norgaard in Harlan April 23, 1967. He helped his brother-in-law farm for around 20 years and was custodian at the Harlan High School for 20 years. He had lived in Harlan prior to moving to the Atlantic Nursing and Rehab Center. He died July 30, 2001, at the Atlantic Nursing and Rehab Center at age 67 years.

He was preceded in death by his parents; his two sisters, Evelyn and Marjorie, in infancy, and a brother-in-law, Donald L. Petersen. Surviving are three sisters, Maye Babbitt (Ora "Bill") of rural Avoca; Doris Scott of Atlantic and Betty Petersen of Exira; one brother, Donald Stormer of Atlantic; nieces and nephews.

Funeral services were held Aug. 2, 2001, at the Roland Funeral Home, Atlantic, with Pastor Allen D. Hellwege of Zion Lutheran Church in Atlantic officiating. Burial was in the Atlantic Cemetery. Casket bearers were Garvin Babbitt, Kenny Hursey, David Petersen, Larry Manz, Ron Goetzinger and Dwayne Larsen.
