HARLAN - Doris Ethel Tague, daughter of Robert and Maggie Duling Dent, was born Sept. 16, 1896 near Kirkman. She was raised near Kirkman and attended rural school there. On Feb. 22, 1914, she married Hoyt Tague at Kirkman and to this union four children were born. They farmed in the Redline and Kirkman areas until their retirement to Harlan in the early 1940's. She had been an active member of the Harlan Church of Christ. She died Aug. 18, 1989 at her home in Harlan at age 92 years, 11 months and 2 days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband Hoyt in 1983; two brothers, Boyd and Gordon Dent and two sisters, Fay McCord and Lovie Fiscus. Survivors include two sons, Wayne of Kerrville, TX. and Hoyt Jr. of Mountain Home, AK. and two daughters, Melba Jorgensen of Harlan and Linnie, Mrs Morrie Rice of Omaha, NE.; a brother, Glenn Dent of Onawa and a sister, Lotia Fiscus of Atlantic.
