SHELBY - Dorothy Alberta Taylor, the daughter of Harry and Laura K. (Furgeson) Millis, was born on a farm near Tipton, MO., on April 18, 1912. She died July 28, 1989 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital, Harlan, at age 77, three months and 10 days. As a young girl, she moved to a farm near Bolan, IA.
