

## **Albert William Tearney, 66**

**Dec. 7, 1925 — Oct. 14, 1992**

**MANILLA** - Albert, son of William and Florence Schielder Tearney was born Dec. 7, 1925 at Guthrie Center. After graduating from Guthrie Center High School in May of 1944, he worked on the home farm for several years. He served in the U.S. Army from Sept., 1946 until July 1947 when he was honorably discharged. He then returned to the Guthrie Center area.

Dec. 26, 1955, he married Irma Bruck at Earling. Eight children were born to this union. After living in AK., for ten years, where he attended automotive repair schools, they moved to Harlan. While living there they built the Automatic Transmission Service in Denison. Since 1967 they have made their home in Manilla. He retired from the automotive repair business in 1987. The next year his wife, Irma, died. He was a member of Sacred Heart parish and the Knights of Columbus. He had been in failing health for several years before his death Oct. 14, 1992 at Clarkson Hospital in Omaha, at age 66 years, 10 months and 7 days.

Besides his wife, he was preceded in death by his parents and by a brother, Max.
