## **Irma Clara Tearney, 55**

**MANILLA** – Irma, daughter of Tony and Mary Bissen Bruck, was born Nov. 16, 1933 in Earling. She graduated from Earling High School.

Dec. 26, 1955 she married Albert William Tearney at Earling. They lived in Harlan for a short time before moving to Alaska where they lived for 10 years.
