DENISON — Louis August Thiede was born Dec. 20, 1924 on a farm in Sac County, the son of Louis Henry Thiede and Ella Marie Hansen Thiede. He died Jan. 1, 1988 at the Jennie Edmondson hospital in Co. Bluffs. He grew to manhood in Sac County and attended rural schools as well as Kiron High School. He was baptized at the St. John's Lutheran Church, Stockholm twp. in 1924 and was confirmed there in 1937.
