Raymond (Ray) Tremel, 75

Oct. 10, 1921 - Dec. 23, 1996

DENVER, CO - Raymond Jr. Tremel was born on Oct. 10, 1921 in Grove Township, Shelby County. He died in Denver General Hospital in Denver, CO, Dec. 23, 1996, at age 75 years, two months and 13 days. The cause was asthma and heart disease. He was engaged in farming for 10 years near Earling and Panama and was forced to quit because of health conditions.

He married Frances Graf Jan. 1946, and to that union four daughters were born, Carol, Pauline, Marie and Laurie. In 1956, they moved to Denver, CO, where they owned and operated a poultry farm for 16 years. After the poultry farm years, he was a supervisor and maintenance engineer at the Ideal Building now known as the 821 Building. He retired about 10 years ago to a life of fishing, traveling and crafts, etc.

Funeral services were held at St. Rose of Lima Church in Denver and burial was in Mt. Olivet Cemetery.
