Nadine True, 76

AVOCA – Neva Nadine True was born Dec. 27, 1923 at Hancock, the daughter of Lawrence and Edith Fletcher McKinny and was one of six children in the family. She attended school in Hancock and graduated in 1941.

Nadine married Howard True Nov. 27, 1942, at the Hancock Methodist Church in Hancock. They were the parents of four children, Larry, Tom, Patty and Wendy. They made their home in Aberdine, MD, until Howard was released from the Army in 1945, and then they made their home in Avoca. Nadine worked at the Colonial Manors Nursing Home and later owned and operated the Avoca Fabric Center. She also cared for both sets of parents in her home. She was a member of the United Church of Avoca. She died March 4, 2000, in Kansas City, MO, at the home of her daughter at age 76 years, two months and six days.

She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Howard, who died in 1989; three brothers, Duane, Lyle and LaVerne; and two sisters, Phyllis Porter and Eileen Cavanaugh. She is survived by her children, Larry True (Rogene) of Belton, MO; Tom True (Jane) of Avoca; Patti (Michael) Waters of Atlantic; and Wendy (Tim) Witcig of Kansas City, MO; 10 grandchildren, three great grandchildren; nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held March 9, 2000, at the United Church of Avoca with Rev. Will Bynagte officiating. Burial was in Graceland Cemetery.
