

Earling woman killed in one-vehicle accident

IRWIN -- A 30-year-old Earling woman was killed Sunday, May 18 after she was ejected from the vehicle she was driving west of Irwin.

Jill Marie Veylupek was taken to Myrtue Medical Center by Defiance Ambulance following the accident.

According to Iowa Highway Patrol reports, Veylupek

was driving a 2006 Chevrolet westbound on County Road F24 about 1/2-mile west of County Road M36.

The vehicle traveled off the roadway to the left, then back to the right before striking a northbound ditch, reports said. The vehicle rolled multiple times, and Veylupek was ejected from the vehicle.

The vehicle came to rest in a field north of County Road F24.

The accident occurred at approximately 9:27 p.m. Sunday evening. Other details of the accident were not available.

The Iowa Highway Patrol was assisted at the scene by the Shelby County Sheriff's Office and Defiance and Irwin Rescue squads.
