## Helen Wherrett, 80

Harlan - Helen F. Wherrett, daughter of John and Anna (Larson) Skidmore was born June 23, 1914 at Diamond Bluffs, WI. In 1981, because she had developed Parkinson's Disease, they returned to Harlan to retire. June 18, 1990 she became a resident of the Baptist Memorial Home and this has been her home since that time. She died Jan. 9, 1995 at Myrtue Memorial Hospital at age 80. She was a member of First Baptist Church in Harlan. She had a beautiful musical talent, and for the 25 years that she lived in Albert Lee was the church organist at the Baptist Church there.
