

Ronald Wiig, 35 ✓

CATHEDRAL CITY, CA. — Ronald Mark Wiig, son of C. Howard and Mary Wiig was born July 31, 1957 at Harlan. He attended school at Irwin, graduating in 1976.

After school, he became employed at the Salem Lutheran Nursing Home in Elk Horn, in housekeeping. Later he moved to Norfolk, NE., where he worked as cook in the hospital there. In 1985, he moved to North Hollywood, CA., where he worked as a cook in the Windsor Manor Nursing Home in Glendale. In 1990, he became ill and was unable to continue working, but continued to reside in North Hollywood before moving to Cathedral City, CA. This was his home until he died Nov. 7, 1992, at age 35, three months and seven days.

He is survived by his mother, Mary (Laverne) Nelson of Irwin; his father, Howard Wiig of Harlan; one sister, Barb (Mark) Kanne of Harlan; 3 brothers, Richard (Renaë) and Robert (Denise) Wiig of Irwin; Roger (Michele) Wiig of Spencer; his friend and life partner, Allen Reed of Cathedral City, CA.; nieces and nephews; aunts, uncles and cousins.
