Lutz, FL - Harry J. Woltmann, Sr., son of Adolph and Emma Schnickloth Woltmann was born in Corley Sept. 23, 1901 and died at his home in Lutz, FL Jan. 17, 1995 at age 93 years, three months and 25 days.

He married Ruth Paulsen July 14, 1932. They were the parents of four children. He worked in the Avoca area until Feb., 1943, when he moved to Omaha, working for the Omaha Steel Works. In 1946 he moved to Lutz, FL. He retired from Robbins Lumber Company as a mechanic. He was a Boy Scout leader, a member of the Civil Air Patrol, Lutz Volunteer Fire department, Order of Eagles and Odd Fellows, and a member of Sunlake Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Ruth, in 1946, his parents, four brothers and five sisters. Survivors include two sons, Harry Jr. and Dale L. of Lutz, FL, two daughters Shirley M. Page of Lutz, FL and Margaret E. Posey of Tampa, FL, a sister, Clara Ronnfeldt of Walnut, and a sister-in-law Meta Woltmann also of Walnut, 13 grandchildren and seven great-grandchildren.

Funeral services were held Jan. 19, 1995 at Land O' Lakes Chapel, F.T. Blount Co. with burial at the Garden of Memories in Tampa, FL.
