## **Donald John Wulff, 76**

**Nov. 14, 1915 — July 10, 1992**

**HANCOCK** — Donald John Wulff was born on a farm south of Minden, Nov. 14, 1915. He was the son of Wilbur and Lillie Matzen Wulff. He attended country school and the Minden High School and graduated in 1933.

He married Abbie Campbell June 7, 1941 at Carson. They made their home on the family farms in the Minden and Hancock areas. They were the parents of four children. He was very active in church and community activities. He was a member of the Silver Creek Methodist Church and served on the board of trustees and superintendent of the Sunday school, also on the board of directors of the West Pottawattamie Seed Corn Assoc.; served as a 4-H leader for many years; was a member of the Farm Bureau; the Pork Producers and the Shelby Saddle Club. He died suddenly July 10, 1992 at the Jennie Edmundson Hospital in Co. Bluffs at age 76 years, 7 months and 26 days.

He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant son. Survivors include his wife Abbie; their children, Kathleen (Douglas) Jacobsen, living near Shelby; Dennis Wulff (Patricia), living near Minden; Roger Wulff (Mary Ann), also living near Minden; one brother, Paul Wulff (Shirley) of Co. Bluffs; 8 grandchildren; two sisters, Ramona Wagner of Co. Bluffs; and Elaine Whitney of Albany, GA.; besides nieces, nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held July 13, 1992, at the Silver Creek Methodist Church in Hancock with Rev. Douglas Cue, officiating. Burial was in the Silver Valley cemetery in Hancock.
