

Danial Weihs, 50

WALNUT — Danial Lee Weihs was born on September 25, 1962 in Atlantic to Harold "J.J." and Letha Lucille (Ward) Weihs. He was one of seven children. Danial attended school in Atlantic and graduated with the Class of 1981.

Danial met Amy Renee Jensen at the roller skating rink in Atlantic and the couple united in marriage on August 5, 1983 at the First United Presbyterian Church in Atlantic. Four children were born to this union: Amy Marie, Joshua Danial, Whitney Leah and Katie Jo. The family remained in Marne for 30 years before they moved to Walnut eight years ago. Danial worked as a hired hand for Dale Kuehl at Big Foot Farms in Atlantic for over twenty years. He helped with hogs and also with fieldwork. Danial died on Saturday December 1, 2012 at Cass County Memorial Hospital in Atlantic having attained the age of 50 years, 2 months and 6 days.
