

Darrell Dean Weisenborn, 59

Aug. 22, 1938 - Jan. 16, 1998

CARROLL - Darrell Dean Weisenborn, age 59, of Carroll, died unexpectedly Jan. 16, 1998, enroute to St. Anthony Regional Hospital in Carroll. He lived many years in Harlan, moving to Carroll Aug. 15, 1997. He was a teacher and was head of the business department at Kuemper Catholic High School. He was born Aug. 22, 1938, at Sac City, and was the son of Fred William and Lura Elizabeth (Treat) Weisenborn.

He married Marna Weisenborn Sept. 7, 1958, at the Pomeroy Methodist Church.
