OREGON CITY, OR – Wilma L. Wilson, whose maiden name was Masters, died May 12, 2002, in Oregon City, OR. She was born in Iowa and was educated at the Gregg College in Chicago. She worked at Harlan National Bank, and then came to Portland, OR, in 1939, where she was employed by the Bank of California and later worked for Interstate Tractor & Equipment Co. From there she went to Northwest Livestock PCA from which she retired as an officer in 1977.

She is survived by a niece, Ann Masters. At her request, there was no service. She was cremated, and her ashes were placed on the grave of her husband, John D. Wilson, in Willamette National Cemetery.
