

Donald Wingert, 55

July 30, 1942 - May 21, 1998

OMAHA, NE - Donald Peter Wingert was born July 30, 1942, in Panama, son of Alfred and Antilia Wingert, Sr. He graduated from St. Mary's Catholic High School in 1960. After two years at Conception Seminary College in Conception, MO, he joined the U.S. Air Force. He served from 1964 to 1968 including 15 months in Taiwan.

He married Angeline Ohlinger Aug. 10, 1968. They lived in Omaha, where he worked at the Boys Town Dairy Farm from 1972 to 1992 and at St. Wenceslaus Church and School from 1992 to 1998. He was a member of St. Wenceslaus Catholic Church, Catholic Engaged Encounter, St. Steven's Center volunteers, CLC, and Antioch community. He died May 21, 1998, at age 55 years.
