

Ronald Lee Woodin, 32

Dec. 12, 1967 - March 1, 2000

ATLANTA, GA – Ronald Lee Woodin was born in Des Moines, Dec. 12, 1967, son of Dennis and Carol (Mathiesen) Woodin. He was baptized, confirmed and was a member of the First United Methodist Church in Harlan, and was an active member of the M.Y.F. youth group. He attended and graduated from Harlan Community High School in 1986. He also attended Iowa State University and Kansas State University. As a young boy he was a member of 4-H and Future Farmers of America, where he held various offices and was a member of the State Livestock judging team in 1986. He was a saxophone player from grade five through grade twelve and a member of the High School Jazz Band.

Dec. 21, 1992, he married Jackie Woodall. To this union two children were born. Ron and Jackie lived in Orlando, FL, where he worked in the cellular telephone business. He died at the Erlanger Hospital in Chattanooga, TN, March 1, 2000, as the result of an automobile accident at age 32 years, two months and 17 days. At the time of his death he was residing in Atlanta, GA.

He was preceded in death by his grandparents, Virgil and Kathryn Mathiesen. He is survived by his two sons, Blake Thomas Woodin and Bailey Michael Woodin; and their mother, Jackie of Orlando, FL; his parents, Dennis and Carol Woodin of Harlan; his brother, Randy Woodin of Harlan; his grandparents, Ronald and Beulah Woodin, also of Harlan; several aunts, uncles and cousins and other relatives.
