

Jackson R. Young, 79

Sept. 3, 1920 – Feb. 15, 2000 †

IRWIN – Jackson Reed Young was born Sept. 3, 1920, to Mabel (Axland) and Raymond Young, on the family farm near Irwin. He was baptized at and was a life member of Church of Christ in Irwin. He attended school in Irwin, and was a graduate of the Irwin High School Class of 1939. After graduation, he joined his father and brother in the operation of the family farm which was homesteaded in 1871. He remained on the farm until his health declined. Following a lengthy illness, he became a resident of the Avoca Nursing and Rehab Center in Avoca, in October of 1997. He died Feb. 15, 2000, at age 79 years, five months and 12 days.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Mildred Struve. He is survived by his sisters, Lela Hanson of Harlan and Charlotte (Donald) Doonan of Elk Horn; brother, Donald Young of Irwin; nieces and nephews and other relatives.

Funeral services were held Feb. 17, 2000, at Pauley Funeral Home with Ted Sieck officiating. Burial was in Oak Hill Cemetery in Irwin.
