HARLAN - Henry William Zimmerman was born at Ottawa, IL, Sept. 27, 1915. He was the son of Lutie and Nora Bundy Zimmerman and was one of five children in the family. He attended country school in Washington County, KS, and graduated from the Morrowville, KS High School with the class of 1933.

He married Goldie Menzies Jan. 8, 1938, at Belleville, KS. They made their home in Kansas until 1944, when they moved to Minden. They were the parents of five children. He was employed by Minden Implement and also the Minden Bowl. Nov. 1, 1963, they moved to Harlan where they managed the Harlan Country Club for 14 years. He retired in December of 1978. He was a past vice president of the Iowa Golf Course Superintendents Association. Goldie died April 19, 1994. He died at Little Flower Nursing Home March 14, 1998, at age 82 years, five months and 12 days.
