Services for Mrs. Chris M. Abild, 68, of S. W. Sixty-Third Street and McKinley Avenue, were held Friday afternoon at McLaren Funeral Home with burial in Orillia. Mrs. Abild died of cancer on Wednesday of last week at Mercy Hospital.

Mrs. Abild, who had been ill several months, was born at Winterset and had lived here 39 years. She was a member of the Baptist Church at Winterset, the Plain View Community Club and the Orillia Embroidery Club.

She is survived by her husband; a daughter, Mrs. Marjorie Miller of Des Moines, a brother, Riley Kemplin, living in Illinois; a sister, Mrs. Elva Webb living in Washington State and one grand-daughter.
