Anderson, Annie D.; born March 29, 1872 at Commerce, IA; died September 30, 1947 in Center Twp., Winterset, IA of mitral heart disease, chronic nephritis; father was Herder Groth, born in Germany; mother was Carolina Schneider, born in Germany; husband was Axel O. Anderson; buried in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery on October 02, 1947; Informer was Harry F. Anderson; physician was Glenn J. Anderson; A. A. Richards was the Funeral Director.

Obituary

[Winterset Madisonian, Wednesday, October 01, 1947]

Mrs. Annie O. Anderson died at her home in Winterset Tuesday morning. Her death occurred at her home on North First Street where she had lived since coming to Winterset, after the death of her husband in 1908. She was 75 years of age.

Mrs. Anderson was born near Commerce on March 29, 1872. She was married to Axel O. Anderson of Orillia. They were the parents of three children, one son, Herman, dying in infancy, and a daughter, Mabel, dying last January 10.

Surviving are her son, Harry F. Anderson of Winterset; and two grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 3 p.m., this Thursday from the Winterset Methodist church, in charge of the pastor, the Rev. G. L. Hufstader. Burial will be made in the cemetery at Orillia.
