Robert Beck, youngest son of John and Mary Beck, was born March 4, 1873, in Hardin County, PA, and passed away into the other life May 21, 1941, at the home of his sister, Mrs. A. G. Anderson, Cumming, Iowa, at the age of 68 years, 2 months and 17 days.

Robert, with his father's family came to Des Moines, Iowa, from Pennsylvania in 1878; then moved to Warren County, Iowa, near Cumming in 1898.

Robert followed the occupation of farming. Since 1929 he had made his home with his sister, Mrs. A. G. Anderson, where he died.

He leaves to mourn his passing his sister and a large number of other relatives and friends.

Robert Beck was a man of quiet and peaceable disposition. He was honest in business, a good neighbor and an upright citizen.

He was always interested in the best things for the community.

He will be missed by all who knew him.

Services were held at the Galloway Funeral Home at Norwalk, conducted by the Rev. A. N. Simpson, pastor of the Church of Christ of Norwalk. Interment was in the Orillia cemetery.
