A Cumming area farmer, Edward H. Biggs, 58, died Monday at VeteransHospital of uremic poisoning after a four-day illness.

Mr. Biggs was born in Des Moines and had lived near Cumming for 46 years. He belonged to American Legion Post 562.

Services will be at 1:30 p.m. Thursday at Galloway-McLaren's Funeral Home in Norwalk, with burial at OrillaCemetery.

Survivors include a brother, Robert, of Des Moines, and a sister, Mrs. Henrietta Miller of Cumming.

Military Service

He was a private in the Army during World War II; Inducted into service on March 25, 1942 at Fort Des Moines, Iowa; discharged on April 18, 1946 at BHG Brigham City, Utah; served with Co. F., 309 Infantry; serial number was 37189402; belonged to the American Legion Post #562. His parents were Henry A. Biggs and Mabel M. Long, also a brother, Robert Biggs.
