Joint funeral services for Mr. and Mrs. Luther Burkhead, 924 Watrous Ave., will be at 2 p.m. today at Dunn's Southwest Ninth Funeral Home, with burial at Orilla cemetery.

Mr. Burkhead, 75 died Friday following an extended illness. Mrs. Mildred Burkhead, 70, died Saturday of a cerebral hemorrhage.

Mr. and Mrs. Burkhead came to Des Moines 40 years ago from Winterset. Mr. Burkhead retired 12 years ago from the Ankeny Ordnance Plant where he was employed as an electrician. Mr. and Mrs. Burkhead were members of the FortDes MoinesUnitedMethodistChurch.

They are survived by a son, Lowell, Mechanicsville, six grandchildren and nine great-grandchildren, and two sisters, Mrs. Marie Wilcox and Mrs. Naomi Milledge, both of Des Moines. Mrs. Burkhead is survived by three brothers, Glenn Haynes, West Des Moines, Hubert, Des Moines and Donald of Newton.
