Cale, John H., born Dec. 6, 1822 in West Virginia; died Feb 10, 1909 of heart failure at Orilla, Linn Twp., Warren Co., IA; age 86yr 2mo 4da; widower; farmer; his father was Daniel Cale; mother was Rebeca Ulom; buried in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery, Orilla, Linn Twp., Warren Co., IA; L. F. Shank of Des Moines, IA was the Funeral Director; physician was A. L. Cochran.

The funeral of John Harvey Cale, who died at the home of his daughter, Mrs. Thomas Barkley, South Seventh Street, was held yesterday from the OrilliaChurch, Rev. A. A. Thompson of Dexter, an old friend of the family conducted the services. Mr. Cale was 86 years old and had lived in Iowa since 1854. Besides the daughter, Mrs. Barklay, he leaves five children, Mrs. S. W. Knouf of Des Moines, D. D. Cale and Mrs. C. W. Misner of Cumming, H. D. Cale of Denver, and D. B. Cale, who lives on the old homestead in WarrenCounty. He is also survived by sixteen grandchildren and five great-grandchildren. Six of his grandsons acted as pallbearers at the funeral.

Cale, John H., farmer, Sec. 6; P. O. Commerce; is a native of West Virginia, born December 6, 1822, and lived there till fourteen years old, when he emigrated, with his father, to Wayne County, Indiana, and lived there three years; then to Indianapolis; from there to Bloomington, Illinois, and remained for five years; then to Scott County, this state, and from there to this county in the spring of 1855; he was married in Marion County, Indiana, January 27, 1848, to Miss Amelia Penry, a native of Ohio, born April 16, 1825; they have a family of three sons and three daughters, living; Roxana M., Iris G., (wife of Samuel Knouf), Dewitt D., Eldora D., H. D., Douglass B., and David R., deceased; owns a farm of 160 acres.
