Services for Mrs. Julia E. Clark, 75, of near Cumming, who died of a heart attack Saturday at Doctors Hospital, will be at 10:30 a.m. Wednesday at the Westover Funeral Home. Burial will be in Mount Hope Cemetery at Orillia.

Born at Ortonville, Minnesota, Mrs. Clark was a graduate of the Art Institute in Chicago. She taught school in Chicago from 1920 until 1953 when she moved to a farm near Cumming.

She was a member of the Cumming Community Church. There are no immediate family survivors.

Julia E. Clark, residence, Route 1, Norwalk, Iowa was born October 4, 1890 at Ortonville, Minnesota and died October 30, 1965 at Doctors Hospital, Des Moines, Iowa. She was a widow. Her cause of death was coronary thrombosis and cancer of the stomach. She was a school teacher and last taught in 1953. Her husband was Wallace E. Clark. Her father was Charles Amasa Miner and her mother was Elizabeth Nunn. The informer was Byron Brown who was a neighbor. The minister was James Whittaker. The casket spray said "Aunt Julia" on the ribbon. She was buried in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery on November 3, 1965.
