Personally appeared before me the undersigned, Judge of the Probate Court of said County, Samuel A. Cooper, who being duly sworn depereth and saith, that he is more than twenty-one years of age, has no lawful wife living, and that he is no nearer of kin to Martha J. Jewell than second cousins. And that the said Martha J. is a white person more than eighteen years old and has no lawful husband living, is a resident of said County of Meigs, and that there

is no legal objection to the marriage contemplated between the said parties. And further this deponent saith not.

Whereupon, on the 22nd day of July 1869, a license for the marriage of the said Samuel A. Cooper and Martha J. Jewell was issued from said Court and August 2, 1869 a return of the solomination of said marriage was made and filed herein by George Downing a Justice of the Peace in the following words and figures to wit: To the Judge of the Probate Court of Meigs County Ohio. I hereby certify that on the 22nd day of July 1869 Samuel A. Cooper and Martha J. Jewell were joined in marriage by me, a Justice of the Peace by virtue of a License for that purpose issued from said Court

Died at his home 1648 Capital Avenue, Samuel A. Cooper, of cancer of the stomach, November 9, aged 45 years. Interment will take place at Commerce, Thursday at 2 p.m. A short service will be held at the family residence at 9:30 o'clock Thursday morning. Friends will attend without further notice.

Misc.

Interment is given as Commerce but he is in PleasantRidgeCemetery.

Military

He was born June 4, 1836 in Kentucky and died September 21, 1881 in Warren Co., Iowa of pneumonia; age 45yr 3mo 17da; he was in the Civil War; at the time of his enlistment he was in Wapello, Co., Iowa and was 28 years old; entered service on February 24, 1864 at Des Moines, Iowa; was a private in Co. E, 36 Iowa Infantry; taken prisoner April 25, 1864 at Marks Mills, Arkansas; exchanged February 5, 1865; discharged June 5, 1865 at Davenport, Iowa; father was David Cooper; mother was Luella Marsh; wife was Amy Powers; buried in Pleasant Ridge Cemetery.

This information was given by the Veterans Administration but it doesn't agree with the other information on Samuel A. Cooper.

Misc. again

Information on Ancestry indicates that his wife Martha died in Tacoma, Pierce Co., Washington on May 26, 1924 and was buried in Oakwood Hill Cemetery. She was born about 1848. Her father was James Jewell and her mother was Nancy Spring. She was 76 years. In the 1900 census she was living with her daughter Katie and her son-in-law William Gerlach. By 1920 she was still with her daughter, Kate in Long Beach, Washington

Samuel Cooper, Sr., father of Samuel married Catharine Schiblaire on November 2, 1825.

Samuel, Sr. died March 8, 1880.
