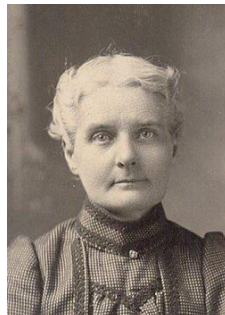

On March 3, 1878, she was married to R. W. Dickey, and to this union were born five children – Mrs. E. D. Surber of Belden, Neb.; Harry, Levenia and Otis, at home, and Ethel of Des Moines., all of whom, with the bereaved husband, were at her bedside when the end came. She is also survived by four grandchildren, five sisters and three brothers. Mrs. Dickey became a member of the M. E. Church in her girlhood days and remained a faithful member all her life. She was a true Christian wife and mother and a kind friend, and will be sadly missed by those near and dear to her. She bore her illness with Christian fortitude, and was ready for the Master's call when the summons came. The remains were brought to her old home at Orillia, Iowa, Tuesday morning, June 24<sup>th</sup>, and the funeral was held at 2 o'clock in the afternoon from the M. E. Church and was largely attended by the old-time friends and neighbors of Mrs. Dickey. The services were conducted by Rev. Mr. Harris, a former pastor of the deceased.
