Fred H. Hall, 74, formerly of Des Moines, died Sunday at his home at Cumming. Services will be at 2 p.m. Wednesday at the Galloway Funeral Home at Norwalk. Burial will be at Orillia.

Born at Union City, Michigan, Mr. Hall, a farmer, had lived at Cumming six years, previously living in Des Moines 22 years. While living here, Mr. Hall was a millwright at Spencer Kellogg and Sons, Inc., 22 years. He was a member of the Baptist Church.

Surviving are his widow, Lutha; five daughters, Mrs. Frank Argo of Wright, Mrs. William Peairs of San Diego, California, Mrs. Pahl Thompson of Corydon, Mrs. Harry Healey of

Dayton, Ohio, and Mrs. N. C. Jackson of Waterloo; two sons, H. Earl of Cumming, and Navy Lt. Glenn, stationed at Quonset Point, R. I., and seven grandchildren.
