Filed for record this 25<sup>th</sup> day of November 1896

V. M. Clarey as principal and J. E. Stiffler and C. F. Snyder as sureties, all of the County of Warren in the State of Iowa, are held and firmly bound unto the County aforesaid, and to all persons herein concerned, in the penal sum of Three Thousand dollars, for the payment of which, well and truly to be made, we do jointly and severally bind ourselves and our lawful representatives.

Witness our hands this 24<sup>th</sup> day of November 1896

The condition of the above obligation is such, that whereas, the above named V. M. Clarey was on this day appointed by the District Court of said County, Administrator of the estate of Henry Knouf deceased, late of said County, who died on or about the 25<sup>th</sup> day of October 1896, to administer all and singular the goods and chattels, moneys, rights, and credits, according to law.

Now if the said V. M. Clarey shall discharge all the duties which are or may be hereafter required of him by law as such Administrator then these presents to be void, otherwise to remain in full force and effect in law.
