

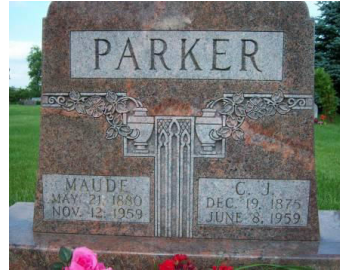

Rites Thursday

Services for Clyde Parker, 83, of 209 Eighth St., West Des Moines, will be at 3:30 p.m. Thursday at McLaren's Funeral Home in West Des Moines, with burial at Orillia Cemetery.

Mr. Parker died of a heart attack Monday at his home. He had been in ill health several years. He was born in Des Moines, farmed in the Orillia-Commerce area, and lived in West Des Moines the last 24 years, where he operated a filling station until four years ago. He was a member of the Methodist Church in West Des Moines.

Surviving are his wife, Maude; four sons, Clayton, Norwalk, Harold and William, all of West Des Moines, and Clifford, in the armed forces in Louisiana; two daughters, Mrs. Bonnie Miller and Mrs. Viola Cayler, both of West Des Moines.
