Sarah Kathryn Morgan was born in Indiana on July 9, 1852, and died at the home of her daughter August 2, 1931, age 79 years and 23 days.

She has been in poor health the past few years and bedfast the past three months,

When a girl she was baptized into the Christian church and was united in marriage to Benjamin Parratt in 1876, who preceded her in death in 1923. To this union were born two children, Franklin, who died at the age of 5, and Mrs. Maude Parker, who resides near Cumming, Iowa.

She is also survived by six grandchildren, one great-granddaughter, two sisters, Mrs. Fannie Rockefeller, Mrs. Eva Todd, and one brother, Lafe Morgan.

Mrs. Parratt lived an active Christian life and was always anxious to help others. Interment was made in the PleasantRidgeCemetery.
