Private services for Earl L. Squires, 58, of Route 1, West Des Moines, who died of a heart ailment Wednesday at VeteransHospital, will be at 1:30 p.m. Friday at the Caldwell-Brien Funeral Home. Burial will be in the cemetery at Orillia.

Born in Runnells, he had lived near West Des Moines, 35 years. He had been employed by Des Moines Ice and Fuel Co.

Surviving are his widow, Gertrude; two daughters, Mrs. Herbert Main and Mrs. Theodore Akey, both of Des Moines, and a sister, Mrs. Von Robertson, of West Des Moines.
