SEPTEMBER 6, 1900 - JANUARY 1961

Carroll LeRoy McPeak began the work on this history of the McPeak family in 1956. Much credit is due him for the time and effort he spent on this work, some of it probably would never have been found without his determination to get the information needed to fit the records in their proper place.

As this work is carried on, we hope it would have met with his approval, had he been able to read it over.

We hope the readers of this book will appreciate the work that has been done by him, although he was unable to finish it as he had hoped.

P R E F A C E

Well, here I am endeavoring to unscramble and put on paper the thoughts, memories and hopes of over one half of a century, that are tumbling helther-skelter through my mind trying desperately to emerge in some semblance of order. I cannot lay claim to very many, if any, of these as absolutely my own creation because as a very small child a person's thoughts, memories, etc., are beginning to be molded and seeds planted for later memories, some of which are to become so real in later life that they seem to have been actual experiences.

However large or difficult that this project appears to me at this time, I intend, with the help of everyone that will permit me, to impose on their time and memories; all the information I can gain from research of old letters, newspapers and clippings; even any I can gather from old county records in the various states involved, and the studying and copying of old photographs. With all this, I will do the best I can in as much as I will be physically and financially unable to travel to gather information and will have to rely on our mails for my research.

As a child, we all remember at times, some relative or other being mentioned by our parents and wondering who they were. If we inquired we might be told that the party mentioned was our cousin, Aunt So and So's child, or our answer might have been a curt "Oh, one of your cousins, you never saw him", and that was the end of it.

Then there were the big massive old photograph albums. My, such ornate and beautiful creations! Also, numerous studio photographs that couldn't find room in the albums. Oh, those albums were almost as sacred as the old family Bible, and never a mark of pencil or pen must

ever mar or blemish those beautiful expensive photographs, and surely they were just that, because most of the ones that I am referring to, and from which I expect to make copies for this project were practically all taken before the turn of the 20th century. In fact, quite a few of them date back to the very first photography: Daguerreo type, tin types, glass plate positives, glass plate negatives, from which the pictures were printed, etc. All of these required very careful posing for several minutes to obtain a good picture, and I have often marveled at the lasting quality obtained by those early day photographers in their pictures.

However, to return to the "beef" (as it were) of my thoughts, by being so careful and particular of the photos, they were left very much unidentified. Oh, of course, when the notion hit one of our parents, they would open the album and show us kids, and say, "This was Grandmother So and So", etc. Some of this information stuck a little but most of it was forgotten and actual dates and places were never mentioned or very little. I hope that with the help of the few relatives still living, and those I am able to contact will be able to establish some of the dates and obtain a little information on our common ancestors.

APRIL 1958

Now after a little over a year of corresponding with numerous relatives, my research is nearing completion and I am very happy with the results of my efforts. I am more than proud of all my numerous cousins whom I never had any idea existed before I started this project. They have all been so very friendly and have rendered me all the assistance they possibly could.

In having such scant knowledge of our parent's families, I was unable

in most cases, to contact any of them direct, so I wrote letters of inquiry to the city clerks of the various towns where I thought some of them might have lived at one time and the results were astounding. I made contact with several descendants of our parents and ancestors in this manner, and they gave me clues which lead me to further contacts and now besides having gained extensive knowledge of our families and their ancestors, I have also gained numerous delightful friends among my cousins. A few of them are my first cousins and others farther removed which fact will be related in the history which will follow.

I am especially grateful to my first cousins: Mabel Smith, La Crescenta, California; Stanley MacPeak, Mason City, Iowa; Donald McPeak, Rochester, Minnesota; Verne Crawford, Kansas City, Kansas; Lloyd Owen, Cheyenne, Wyoming. My father's first cousins: Minnie Riggs, Reseda, California; Rena Gould, Hot Springs, South Dakota. My second cousins: (Children of my mother's first cousins) Esther Kershner, widow of LeRoy Kershner, Wheatland, Wyoming; Charlotte Douglass, Seattle, Washington; also, Randal Kershner (son of my first cousin, LeVern), Lubbock, Texas; Hazel Child, my sister-in-law, Bountiful, Utah, and a friend, Mrs. Edith Kelly, Belleville, Kansas, all of whom have very kindly supplied me with very valuable and interesting information, and most of them have either given or loaned me old photographs from which to have copies made for my history. They have also rendered great assistance in identifying the numerous unidentified photographs from my parent's collection.

Now there remains the task of compiling and writing our family history in a manner which will be both interesting and accurate in details. This will depend largely on my abilities as a writer and genealogist of which

I have had no previous training or experience, but if honest, sincere, conscientious effort will mean anything, I should emerge with something that will be, at least, acceptable.

I do not believe that I would ever have even thought of this project if it wasn't for our daughter, Billie Carol, and remembering when I was a young man and listening to others telling about their families, and I not knowing anything at all about mine. This gave me the desire to leave her a means of learning about her families.

So I wish to dedicate these efforts and the resulting histories to the love and affection that I hold for her, and hope that her memories of her father may be a little enhanced by them.

McPEAK

First Generation in U. S. A.

There is a tradition that has been handed down in this family from generation to generation placing our early ancestors in Northern Scotland, belonging to the MacDougal Clan, and telling us that at least some of the family emigrated to Northern Ireland at one time. Also, that more than a century and one half ago, probably about 1800, four McPeak brothers emigrated to the U. S. A. They were William, James, Charles and Jack.

At this point our old family tradition seems to contradict itself. Some of it indicates that these four brothers came from Northern Scotland, and other versions of it place their embarking point as Northern Ireland. However, that being as it may, the four brothers landed in Virginia, and shortly after landing they became separated and were never reunited, as far as I have ever been able to learn.

There is nothing further known about three of the brothers, whose given names were James, Charles and Jack. However, there are many families of McPeaks scattered over the United States that must be remotely related to us, but no one has ever been able to establish a common ancestor between us because so many names and facts have become lost through the years.

William, the fourth brother, and my great-great grandfather, who was our first ancestor in this country, gradually worked westward and sometime prior to 1813 settled in White County, Tennessee, with his wife named Martha, my great-great grandmother. They had a double-log cabin

near Sparta, Tennessee, located by a little stream called, "Calf Killer Creek".

There is nothing in the records to indicate the family name of Martha or if she and William were married in this country or the old country, but tradition has it that she was a very gracious woman with beautiful long hair that reached the floor. William and Martha had a very numerous family, nine or perhaps ten children that came to maturity. Probably all were born near Sparta, Tennessee.

In 1826, William moved his family from Tennessee to Macoupin County, Illinois where Martha died in 1838. William married again and it is thought that they had another child, but there is no record that shows this, or the name of his second wife. William was killed in an accident on October 9, 1845. That morning he had set out with a team and wagon to haul cordwood and when he hadn't returned home by night his wife sent for his eldest son, James (her step-son), and he found him after a search. The wagon, loaded with cordwood, had tipped over pinning him between the wagon and a tree crushing his chest. He still held the lines in one hand; the team still hitched to the wagon. They had remained quiet and the wagon hadn't moved since the accident.

There are no records of the birth dates of either William or Martha but we know they were born before 1800, and nothing at all is known about William's second wife.

The following is an account of the descendants of William and Martha McPeak, compiled to the best of my ability after considerable correspondence and research. William and Martha had five sons, James, John, Charles, William Carl, and Jack. Their five daughters were Margaret, Louise, Linda and two others whose given names are unknown.

McPEAK

Second Generation in U. S. A.

James McPeak, 1813-1891, son of William and Martha McPeak and my grandfather, was born near Sparta, White County, Tennessee, January 21, 1813, and moved with his parents, brothers and sisters from Tennessee to Macoupin County, Illinois when he was 13 years old.

On July 31, 1834, he was married to Rebecca Crowder of Lexington, Kentucky. They lived in Macoupin County, Illinois until 1846, when they moved to a claim near Andrew, Jackson County, Iowa. In about 1858, they sold their homestead near Andrew and bought a farm near Maquoketa, Jackson County, Iowa, living there until in 1879, then they moved to a farm three miles north of Clay Center, Nebraska. Three years later in 1882, they sold this farm and purchased a home in Fairfield, Nebraska, where they spent the remaining years of their lives. James died May 6, 1891, and Rebecca died January 25, 1899, both were buried at Fairfield, Nebraska.

James and Rebecca McPeak had fifteen children. Their nine son's names were George W., William C., Andrew J., Calvin E., Alexander C., Charles, James, Anthony, and Arthur G. The six daughter's names were Martilla, Elizabeth Ann, Mary Ann, Sarah Ellen, Matilda and Amelia. The histories of these and their families are under the next generation.

THE AVAILABLE HISTORY OF THE CROWDER FAMILY

In about 1809 Elizabeth Wise and her parents emigrated to the U. S. A. from Wales, Great Britain, but her parents died on board ship during the long trip. Elizabeth was 16 years old, and the captain of the ship

held her for the passage. The record isn't very clear at this point, but apparently the captain must have sold her into bondage to recover the cost of her family's passage. However, a few years later she married a man by the name of William B. Crowder. Nothing much is known about him except that he was of a German descent and that there seemed to be some kind of connection between Crowder and the captain of the ship which brought her from Great Britain.

William B. Crowder and Elizabeth Wise Crowder settled in Kentucky and raised a family of six children; four daughters, Rebecca, Elizabeth, Jane and Louisa, and two sons, James and Daniel.

William B. Crowder died on March 7, 1858, probably in Kentucky. Elizabeth Wise Crowder died February 27, 1874, at Beatrice, Nebraska, while visiting her grandson, Alex Conley, who lived there.

THE KNOWN MEAGER HISTORY OF THE CROWDER DESCENDANTS IS AS FOLLOWS:

Rebecca, daughter of William and Elizabeth Crowder and my great grandmother, was born in Kentucky on February 16, 1818, and was married to James McPeak on July 31, 1834. After an illness of three months, she passed away at Fairfield, Nebraska on January 25, 1899.

Elizabeth, daughter of William and Elizabeth Crowder, was born in Kentucky, but there are no dates available. She married John Conley or Conlee (tradition has it spelled both ways). They had a large family, however, I found data on only two sons. A son, Alex Conley, published the "Beatrice Currier" in Beatrice, Nebraska and later held a clerkship in Washington D. C. Another son was named Jack Conley but there is nothing more known about him nor the rest of the family.

Jane, daughter of William and Elizabeth Crowder, (no dates) married Curt Woods, which tradition relates as being wealthy. He owned thousands of acres of land in Kansas, and went to California in 1849 during the gold rush. Nothing more is known about them.

Louisa, daughter of William and Elizabeth Crowder, (no dates) married Monroe Conley; records do not show whether he was related to John Conley or not. Monroe Conley was a Methodist minister. Monroe and Louisa staked mining claims in the vicinity of Pikes Peak, Colorado. They later sold them for \$40,000 and used it to build a church. Tradition tells us this much, but neglects to tell us where they built the church.

Daniel, son of William and Elizabeth Crowder, (no dates) was killed in the Mexican War. No other information is available.

James was another son of William and Elizabeth Crowder, but there are no other dates or data available on him either.

This ends the available history of the Crowder family.



HUGH RAY McPEAK

SEPTEMBER 7, 1892 -

Hugh R. McPeak has tried to carry on this work begun by Carrol LeRoy McPeak, having had access to more records and finishing some that were started by him. Hugh has traveled to several places his folks lived, and has searched court house records for information besides many personal interviews.

Many records have been destroyed by homes burning, court houses burning, and persons moving to different locations where packing and unpacking made it possible for things to become lost.

Perhaps this work will be in keeping with that which was begun by Carrol LeRoy McPeak. We hope so.

F O R W A R D

In beginning this forward of the history of the McPeak family, we will start the tradition that the McPeaks were originally in Scotland and were of the McDougal Clan, and through some sovereign trouble had to leave Scotland.

They went to Ireland and from there four brothers, William, James, Charles and Jack came to America and landed in Virginia. We find from authentic records, such as census and court house records that William and James were in White County, Tennessee near Sparta.

William McPeak and his wife, Martha (other name unknown) had their first child, James. He was born on January 21, 1813 in a double-log cabin by Calf Killer Creek near Sparta.

The census records of 1820 show that James and William were there and had families. Further searching shows they were brothers. There will be more about the James McPeak branch at the end of the William McPeak history, also other McPeaks.

Along about 1940, I began to get the urge to find out more about my father's side of the house, having already a good history of my mother's side, the Woods family.

My father died on February 2, 1938. I could have gotten a lot of history from him if I had been interested. I do remember him saying that his grandfather came from Ireland, and his name was William.

In 1947, I went to Jackson County, Iowa where I was born near the town of Maquoketa. With my folks, we left there in 1897 and I had never been back since. I visited my cousins, Will and Roy, sons of Isaac and Sarah McPeak, and gathered some information from them. They were both

single and well along in years. Roy had been in an accident and could hardly hear. Will knew me instantly, eventhough he had no knowledge of my coming, and he still has a wonderful memory. He said his parents had a history of the McPeak family dating far back. When his mother died, having survived his father, some of the neighbors came in to clean the house, and a few days later he found the history in the trash pile. It had been rained on and fell to pieces.

My brother, Benjamin, said he had seen the book and the earlier names were spelled "MacPeak", and "McPake" in another place. However, with one exception it has been spelled "McPeak" in this book.

While on a visit to Minnesota in the 1950's, I met a Don McPeak in Rochester; he told me his cousin, Carrol LeRoy McPeak was gathering material for a family history and was living in Laramie, Wyoming at that time. Also, his brother, Stanley of Mason City, Iowa had sent him considerable information on the McPeak family history. I contacted Carrol LeRoy not long after that, and the two of us have gathered some history. C. L. or Roy, as we called him, did the most and deserves much credit for this work.

Roy passed away in January 1961. He wanted so much to get this work done, and I have tried to carry it on as best as I could. I have access to some records that he did not have, and in places our accounts may be slightly different on account of some of my findings obtained after his death. His preface and forward will be separate from mine.

Roy was married to Billie June Adams, and early in his married life became physically unable to do manual labor. He then took up this work, which he could do. After he became unable to work, his wife took over

the support of the family and has done a good job. She has a position as a telephone operator for the Union Pacific Railroad, and was transferred to North Platte, Nebraska before Roy's death. She is still there at this writing. They had one daughter, Billie Carol, and she will graduate this year. Billie Carol is working outside of school hours to help pay her way through college.

My first help in this work, other than my father and brothers was from my cousin, Will McPeak, now deceased.

Another cousin, Mary Pruella (Ella) Scoby, of Maquoketa, Iowa has given me much help in the way of family records, through her Bible records, etc. Her grandfather was Isaac McPeak.

In addition, I have had much help from my second cousin, Ina L. Clowes of Renwick, Iowa helping to correct records and to furnish records from her Bible and the family records of her grandfather, James McPeak. She was left a widow in April 1956 with five children. The oldest son being 17 years old, Ina took over the management of the farm and has done an excellent job in putting the children through school, and managing the affairs of the farm in general. The children have helped greatly. The oldest son is now married, and I believe he lives in Minnesota.

My sister-in-law, Mary McPeak of Renwick, Iowa has helped considerably with the local data of the immediate family; information which I did not have.

I also had some help from my cousin, Addie Livingston, now deceased. Leota Sutton, a distant cousin, furnished me with census records and other data from the Genealogical Library in Salt City, Utah.

During the year 1947, I contacted Wayne McPeak, who was a freight agent in Maquoketa, Iowa. At that time, he told me his folks had a book on the McPeak family, but I did not write the address down then, so I can't locate it.

I have heard there are other reports of the family books, but I have never found one. Letters have been written to many, but they have not answered. Also, I hired a genealogist and received some help but very little.

This FORWARD has been written in my own words and as you have noticed, without literary talent. I have stated and written facts as accurate as I could get them, and they will be that way in the pages to follow in the genealogy part of this book.

Sometime some one may find another book like the one my Uncle Isaac McPeak had, and they can fill in what is lacking in this book.

WILLIAM McPEAK and MARTHA () McPEAK

First Generation

William and Martha are the first in line as we begin the history of the McPeak family. They will be considered the first generation; their children as the second, and so on.

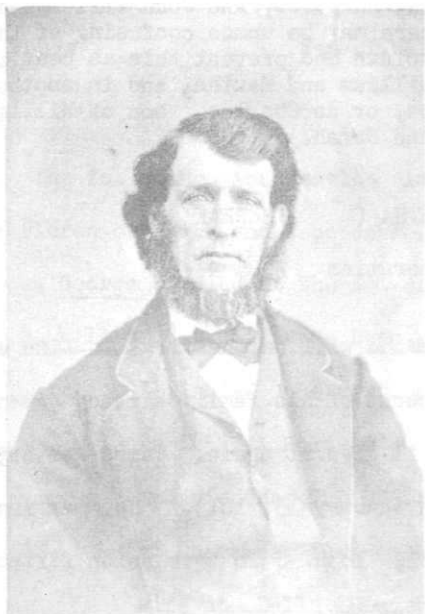
The county records and other information tells us William and Martha were definitely known to have been in what is now known as White County, Tennessee in 1813.

We have no record of Martha's name before being married to William neither do we have the date nor the place of their marriage. Ten children were born to William and Martha; their names as follows:

Baby girl (No name given, may have died at birth)

Little is known about William and Martha McPeak, but we found that William's birth reads about 1787, and he died on October 9, 1845. The date of Martha's birth reads about 1791, and date of death as 1838. They both died in Macoupin County, Illinois, but we have no knowledge of their burial place.

After Martha passed away, William remarried again to a lady by the name of Rebecca Thomas. We have one report that they had a son named, Henry, but this has not been verified. No information is given as to the time of Rebecca's death or the place of her burial.

This is the beginning of the second generation of William and Martha McPeak. James being the first child, and the Genealogy follows on the next page.

James McPeak and Rebecca Crowder were married on July 13, 1834. They lived on a farm near Maquoketa, Iowa until 1879. Then they moved to a farm three miles north of Clay Center, Nebraska; three years later they sold this farm and moved to Fairfield, Nebraska where they bought a home and lived there the rest of their lives. Both are buried at Fairfield, Nebraska.

(As the names of William, James, Charles, Margaret, and John will appear quite often in the McPeak history, there may be some confusing of the different lines, but we will try to explain and prevent this as best as we can. Such as writing James, son of William and Martha, and in another place as James, son of James and Rebecca, or as Charles, son of William and Martha, and Charles, son of Isaac and Sarah.)

WILLIAM McPEAK and MARTHA () McPEAK

Second Generation

James, first child of William and Martha will be the first in line of the second generation. There is an account of his family already given, but to keep the families straight we will give it again. James was born near Sparta, White County, Tennessee on January 13, 1813. He married Rebecca Crowder of Kentucky on July 31, 1834. To this union fifteen children were born, their names are as follows:

Three of the children, Elizabeth Ann, James and Anthony died while young and were buried on the farm where they lived near Maquoketa, Iowa. Elizabeth Ann died at 13½ years, James was only 2 years 10 months old, and little Anthony at the age of one month.

I visited their graves in 1960 while on a visit to Jackson County, Iowa. The markers were in good condition and lettering was quite plain, although some of the stones had fallen down. I think this farm was about four or five miles northeast of Maquoketa. The graves seemed to me to be north and east of the house, although I am not too sure of my directions.

BRANCH of JAMES McPEAK and REBECCA (CROWDER) McPEAK

(Son of William and Martha McPeak)

Third Generation

The following information is the only record we have of the fifteen children of James and Rebecca McPeak:

1. George W. died at the age of 3 months in Macoupin County, Illinois.
2. William Carroll was born August 19, 1837 in Macoupin County, Illinois. He married Melissa Lavina Solomon at Andrew, Iowa in 1857. Melissa was born July 4, 1840 at Alton, Illinois and died May 7, 1900 at Belle Plaine, Iowa. William C. died at Cherokee, Iowa on July 20, 1920. He is buried beside his wife at Belle Plaine, Iowa. They had the following five children:

3. Andrew Jackson was born in Macoupin County, Illinois in 1839. He enlisted in the Union Army during the Civil War, and came out as a Captain in the 31st Iowa Volunteers Infantry. He married Olive Wright on July 14, 1861 and moved to Sutton, Nebraska in Clay County where he was County Sheriff for two terms. Later he became County Treasurer of Arapahoe County, Nebraska, and still later was land agent at Spokane, Washington. Andrew and Olive had one child, a daughter, named Anna, who was born about 1864. They also raised a foster son, named Martin Davis. Olive died May 10, 1900 and Andrew passed away at the Soldiers Home in Leavenworth, Kansas on December 29, 1920.

4. Martilla was born in Macoupin County, Illinois on July 23, 1840. She married Gais Dickinson, a Civil War veteran, at Maquoketa, Iowa. On September 29, 1923, Martilla passed away at Cedar Rapids, Iowa, and Gais died at Tipton, Iowa. They had five children as follows:

5. Elizabeth Ann was born in Macoupin County, Illinois on April 28, 1842, and died on October 5, 1855. She was buried on her parent's place, the old James McPeak farm near Maquoketa, Iowa.

6. Mary Ann was born in Macoupin County, Illinois on January 29, 1844. She married Henry Smith, a blacksmith and farmer at Maquoketa, Iowa, on January 6, 1861. Later they moved to Brush, Colorado where he was a school teacher, and also, a business man connected with the firm of Harris and Smith of Brush, Colorado. Seven children were born to them; their names as follows:

On October 20, 1899, Henry Smith died at Brush, Colorado. Mary Ann married the second time to Allen Minnecar. No dates or other information is given. Mary Ann died in 1928, the place is not given.

7. Sarah Ellen was born in Macoupin County, Illinois on November 24, 1845. She married Wallace Alderman on September 22, 1861. Soon after they were married, Alderman joined an Iowa Regiment and fought in the Civil War; he was captured and died at the Andersonville Prison. There was one son born while Alderman was in prison; they named him Asa Alderman. Later in life, Sarah Ellen married again to a man named Oliver DeFoy. They had several children; the oldest was named Ida. It seems there were three other daughters, whose names are not given. One son was named O. L. DeFoy. Oliver DeFoy died in Waterloo, Iowa, on January 17, 1911, and Sarah Ellen passed away on June 2, 1930 in Winthrop, Iowa. Both Oliver and Sarah Ellen are buried in Mt. Hope Cemetery at Maquoketa, Iowa.
8. Calvin E. was born near Andrew, Jackson County, Iowa, November 4, 1847. He married Cordelia Marlow on March 25, 1869 at Maquoketa, Iowa. They farmed different places around Maquoketa and Spragueville, Iowa. In 1876, they moved from Iowa to Fillmore County, Nebraska near Fairmont, where they lived for three years. Then they moved to Clay Center, Nebraska where they had their own farm. In 1885, they sold out their holdings near Clay Center and bought a very fine farm northeast of Fairfield, Nebraska. Later he traded this farm for a home close to the Christian Normal & Collegiate College, about two

miles from Fairfield. Several years later, they sold this place and bought a home in Fairfield near Calvin's parents and also, bought an interest in a drug store. Cordelia died in Hastings, Nebraska on May 23, 1936. She was born in 1848 and was 88 years old. A few months later, Calvin passed away on December 19, 1936 in Hastings, Nebraska. They had five children as follows:

9. Matilda was born on October 17, 1849 in Jackson County, Iowa. She married Frank Taylor and they had one son by the name of Herbert James. Matilda married for the second time to James Archer. No further records.

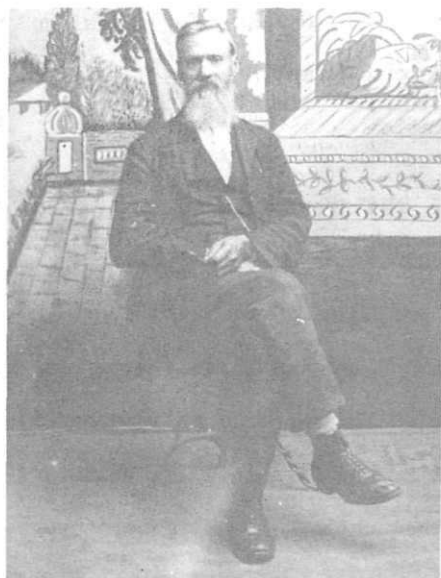

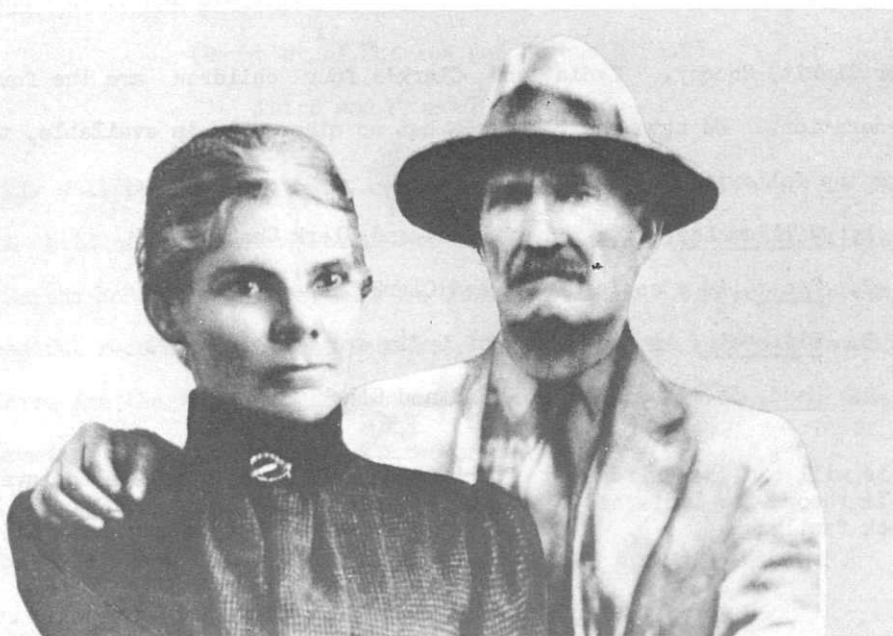

My two brothers, Ned and Verni, and his wife, Dessa; my wife, Laura and I visited in the home of Joe McPeak, in 1960. We three brothers agreed that there was a family resemblance in Joe McPeak, and I feel

sure he is a descendant of James McPeak, who was a brother of my ~~great~~ great grandfather, William McPeak. We have no definite proof; however, there still has to be one name between James McPeak and John Laman McPeak to supply the proof.

There is a Dr. Edgar McPeak in Washington D. C., whose parents died when he was quite young, and he has the same tradition of the four brothers coming to America. Also, I have another reference of a brother of William, whose name was Charles, who married a Betsy Cordel of Pittston, Pennsylvania.

There are many McPeaks scattered throughout the United States. No doubt many are relatives, especially those in Tennessee.
